General Information

Generally speaking, we expect to make decisions concerning courses in May/June for Winter or Fall courses; in October for Spring courses; and in February for Summer courses. However, some decisions may be made earlier or later than these time frames, depending on circumstances. Unexpected vacancies may arise at any time.

Applications will be retained for twelve (12) months. Persons who submit applications and CVs will receive e-mailed job postings for specific positions for the subsequent twelve (12) months.

This notice is posted pursuant to the CUPE 3902 Unit 3 Collective Agreement. Please note that in accordance with that agreement, preference in hiring is given to qualified persons holding the rank of Sessional Lecturer II and Sessional Lecturer III.

Please Note: Undergraduate or Graduate students and postdoctoral fellows of the University of Toronto are covered by the CUPE 3902 **UNIT 1** collective agreement rather than the UNIT 3 collective agreement and should not apply for positions posted under the UNIT 3 collective agreement.
