NEW451H is a senior research-oriented essay course designed to provide advanced Women and Gender Studies students the opportunity to study topics not currently part of the university curriculum. The course begins with a proposal developed by the student and approved by a supervisor. The student meets with the supervisor periodically and produces a substantial paper as a course assignment.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Before the course begins -

- 1. Each student is responsible for finding an appropriate supervisor. Full-time faculty connected with or involved in Women and Gender Studies are the most appropriate supervisors. Note that the supervisor **must be faculty member with an appointment in an academic unit at the University of Toronto**. Sessional instructors are **not** eligible to supervise independent study courses. **Both the supervisor and their departmental chair/college principle/program director or equivalent must sign the contract**.
- 2. Once a supervisor has been found and the nature of the project discussed, this contract must be completed and submitted to the Women and Gender Studies Institute (WGSI) Program Office for approval.
- 3. Registration of all students will be done through the WGSI Program Office after the contract has been submitted and approved. This form must be submitted to the WGSI Program Office (Room 2036, Wilson Hall, New College) by:
 - JUNE 30th for fall session
 - **SEPTEMBER 30**th for winter session
 - MARCH 30th for summer session.
