WGS451Y1 is a senior level research-oriented essay courses designed to provide upper year students in the Women and Gender Studies specialist and major the opportunity to study topics not currently part of the curriculum. The course requires a proposal developed by the student and approved by a supervisor and the WGSU Undergraduate Co-ordinator. Once the term begins, the student meets with the supervisor periodically and produces a substantial paper as a course assignment.

The course is not eligible for the CR/NCR option.

Prerequisite: Enrollment in a WGS specialist or major program, completion of WGS160Y1, WGS260H1, and WGS360H1, a CGPA of at least 3.0 and permission of the Undergraduate Coordinator.

- The student is responsible for finding a supervisor. Full-time faculty with Women and Gender Studies are the most appropriate supervisors. Please look under People>Faculty and Affiliate Faculty at <https://wgsi.utoronto.ca/> Sessional instructors are not eligible to supervise independent study courses.
- Once a supervisor has been found and the nature of the project and the marking scheme agreed to, this form must be completed and submitted to the WGSU Program Office for approval.
- The completed form and a one-page double spaced outline should be submitted to wgsi.programs@utoronto.ca
- Complete proposals should be submitted to WGSU by the appropriate deadline.
 - September 1 for fall/winter session
 - April 30 for summer session.
- The WGSU Program Office will register the student in ACORN after the proposal has been approved

This course may be taken in the Fall /Winter as WGS451Y1 Y or in the summer as WGS451Y1 Y
